Select All	Ctrl + A	Command (⌘) + A
Find	Ctrl + F	Command (⌘) + F

Refresh	F5 or Ctrl + R	Command (⌘) + R

New Window/File	Ctrl + N	Command (⌘) + N
Open File	Ctrl + O	Command (⌘) + O
Close Window	Alt + F4	Command (⌘) + W
Minimize Window	Windows + Down Arrow	Command (⌘) + M
Maximize Window	Windows + Up Arrow	Control + Command (⌘) + F
Switch Between Windows	Alt + Tab	Command (⌘) + Tab

Browser Shortcut Keys

Action	Windows	macOS
Open New Tab	Ctrl + T	Command (⌘) + T
Close Current Tab	Ctrl + W	Command (⌘) + W
Reopen Closed Tab	Ctrl + Shift + T	Command (⌘) + Shift + T
Open Incognito Window	Ctrl + Shift + N	Command (⌘) + Shift + N
Jump to Address Bar	Ctrl + L or Alt + D	Command (⌘) + L

Bold	Ctrl + B	Command (⌘) + B
Italic	Ctrl + I	Command (⌘) + I
Underline	Ctrl + U	Command (⌘) + U
Align Left	Ctrl + L	Command (⌘) + L
Align Center	Ctrl + E	Command (⌘) + E
Align Right	Ctrl + R	Command (⌘) + R

Open File Explorer	Windows + E
Lock Your PC	Windows + L
Take a Screenshot	Windows + Shift + S
Open Settings	Windows + I
Open Task Manager	Ctrl + Shift + Esc

Force Quit App	Command (⌘) + Option + Esc
Take Full Screenshot	Command (⌘) + Shift + 3
Take Selected Screenshot	Command (⌘) + Shift + 4
Open Finder	Command (⌘) + Option + Space
Show Desktop	Command (⌘) + F3
Open Spotlight Search	Command (⌘) + Space
